1. India's GDP to grow by 7.5% in FY26 with upside bias, says SBI report:

India's economy is expected to grow at 7.5 per cent in 2025-26 with upward bias, marginally higher from NSO's estimate of 7.4 per cent, according to a report by State Bank of India. The First Advance Estimates released by National Statistics Office (NSO) put GDP growth in 2025-26 at 7.4 per cent as compared to 6.5 per cent in the previous fiscal. The RBI has projected the growth rate at 7.3 per cent.

3. India may target around 10 percent nominal GDP growth in FY 2026-27 Budget: Report:

India may pencil in a nominal growth rate of about 10% in the coming budget, up from an estimated 8% this fiscal year, said an official familiar with early budget deliberations. The government expects the economic growth momentum to stay robust, while inflation is seen rising in FY27 from the low levels this fiscal, largely due to an unfavourable base effect, the official said.

The Department of Financial Services (DFS) under the Ministry of Finance reported significant progress in banking reforms, digital payments, and financial inclusion during 2025, marking a year of strengthened financial stability and governance, according to a year end review released.

5. Indian economy resilient despite global challenges: Shaktikanta Das:

Principal Secretary-2 to the Prime Minister, Shaktikanta Das, said the Indian economy remains resilient and is expected to be the fastest-growing economy in the world despite geopolitical tensions and trade barriers. Das also cautioned that the share of trade in the global economy has stagnated, a trend that could lead to higher costs and greater vulnerabilities.

6. EV retail sales surge 16.37 percent to over 22.70 lakh units in 2025: FADA:

Electric vehicle (EV) retail sales surged 16.37 per cent year-on-year to 22,70,107 units in 2025, driven by a 77 per cent jump in electric passenger car sales, according to data released by dealers' body FADA. The EV makers had recorded a total sales of 19,50,727 units in 2024, the Federation of Automobile Dealers' Association (FADA) said.

India's automobile sector is set to deliver one of its strongest quarterly performances in years in Q3FY26, with robust demand growth coinciding with a sharp improvement in profitability across segments, according to a sector preview.

8. India's solar module manufacturing more than doubled to 144 GW in 2025:

India's solar module manufacturing has increased to more than twice since last year, Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy Pralhad Joshi. In a social media post, he stated that solar module manufacturing has increased 128.6% on a year-over-year basis to 144 gigawatts (GW) in 2025. It stood at 63 GW in 2024. This implies that India added 81 GW-worth of capacity in the previous year.

India's carmakers ended a turbulent global year on a high, exporting a record number of vehicles, buoyed by rising demand across Africa, South America, and West Asia, cementing the country's place as an emerging manufacturing hub. This surge, a 15% increase over 2024, highlights India's growing manufacturing prowess. However, future growth hinges on trade diplomacy, particularly with Mexico, which has doubled tariffs on Indian goods, potentially impacting outbound shipments.

The Centre has created a three-year Public Private Partnership (PPP) project pipeline covering 852 projects with a total estimated cost of over ₹17 lakh crore, the government said. The pipeline has been prepared by the Department of Economic Affairs (DEA) under the Ministry of Finance, following the announcement made in the Union Budget 2025–26, and spans projects planned by central infrastructure ministries as well as states and Union Territories.

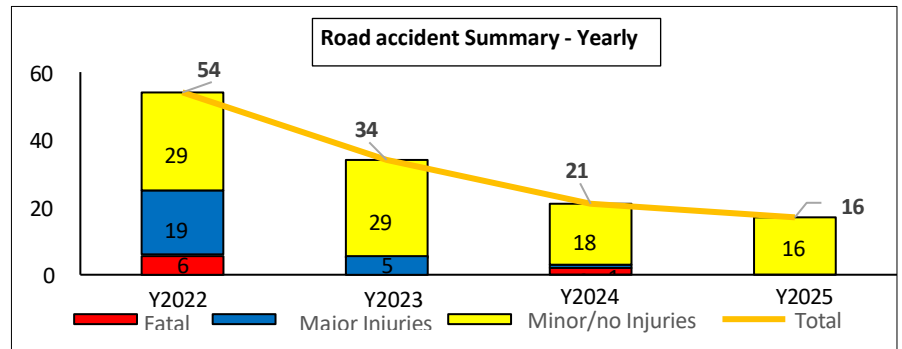
