1. Need to make Indian agri-products export oriented, globally competitive : PM

Prime Minister Narendra Modi emphasised the need to make India's agricultural products more export-oriented and globally competitive during a post-Budget webinar on 'Agriculture and Rural Transformation'. He said improving the global competitiveness of Indian farm produce is essential to strengthening the economy and boosting farmers' incomes.

2. Auto retail sector posts records sales at 2.41 mn units in February : FADA

India's auto retail sector posted its best-ever February sales, as the momentum after the GST 2.0 announcement continued. Total vehicle sales touched 2.41 million units, marking 26 per cent growth year-on-year (Y-o-Y), according to Federation of Automobile Dealers Associations (FADA) data released.

3. India's electric PV retail sales jump 44% in February : Tata Motors leads : FADA

Electric passenger vehicle (PV) retail Sales in India increased 44 percent year on year (YoY) in February, 2026 to 13,733 units, according to data released by Federation of Automobile Dealers Association. However, on a month to month basis, sales declined 25.65 per cent compared with 18,470 units sold in January, 2026, reflecting a typical post January slowdown in retail demand.

6. Govt aims to disburse ₹80 crore subsidy for EV charging points by end of FY26

The Heavy Industries Ministry has begun assessing proposals from state governments and state run oil marketing companies to install charging infrastructure for electric vehicles under the Rs. 10,900 crore PM E-Drive scheme, with the aim of disbursing about Rs. 80 crore by the end of FY26, according to two people aware of the development.

7. Indian refiners buy both sanctioned & non-sanctioned Russian oil after US waiver

Indian refiners have begun purchasing Russian crude cargoes currently at sea after the United States issued a 30-day waiver allowing India to procure Russian oil loaded on vessels as of March 5, providing refiners temporary flexibility to access supplies already in transit.

“After the US announced the waiver, refiners are purchasing both sanctioned and non-sanctioned Russian oil that is currently on water,” a senior official aware of the development said on condition of anonymity.

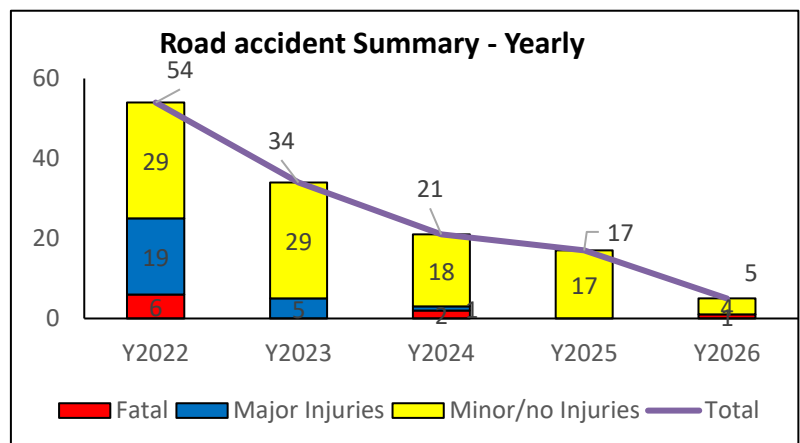

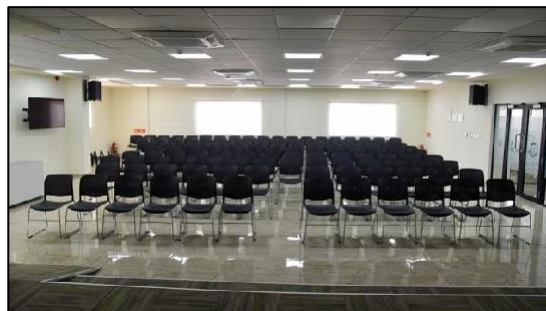

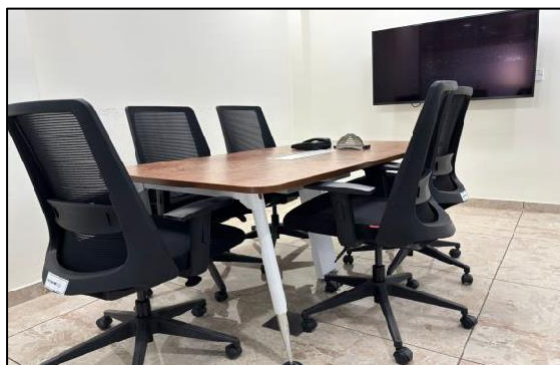
