Part-A: Trade, Investment, Economy, Industry & commerce update

1. India's engineering exports surge 24% to \$12.31 billion in May despite global trade headwinds.

India's engineering exports saw a significant surge in May 2026, reaching USD 12.31 billion. This marks a 24.48 per cent increase compared to the previous year. Cumulative exports for April-May 2026-27 also showed strong growth. Industry leaders credit adaptability and government support for this positive trend. Continued focus on market and product diversification is advised to maintain this momentum.

2. Karnataka exports grow 9.5% in FY26, Bengaluru continues to drive momentum

Karnataka's exports grew by 9.5% year-on-year in 2025-26, with Bengaluru continuing to power the state's export economy through its strong services and technology base, while also contributing significantly to merchandise trade. According to an analysis by the Visvesvaraya Trade Promotion Centre (VTPC), the nodal agency under the state's industries and commerce department for promoting international trade, Karnataka's total exports stood at approximately Rs. 19.7 lakh crore in 2025-26, up from Rs. 18 lakh crore in the previous financial year.

3. Karnataka D K Shivakumar to set up monitoring units for mega projects

Chief Minister DK Shivakumar is setting up a Delivery Monitoring Unit (DMU) in his office so that he can directly supervise the implementation and progress of big projects costing above Rs 100 crore. Senior IAS officer Munish Moudgil has been drafted into the chief minister's office (CMO) as principal secretary for programme and project implementation. He will be involved in DMU, sources said. Shivakumar has less than two years in office to deliver the goods before the state heads to polls in 2028. The DMU, which is being set up, is a part of his plan to focus on infrastructure projects during his tenure.

4. PMVBRY creates 7 million jobs, 1 million workers get incentives : PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said nearly 7 million jobs have been created under the PM Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PMVBRY), while an equal number of first-time employees have been brought under the ambit of social security through the scheme.

Speaking at an event in Vigyan Bhawan, where he disbursed incentives to beneficiaries under the programme, Modi said around 2 million young employees had completed six months in their first job, with 1 million receiving incentive payments as per the scheme's provisions.

5. India-EU target year end signing of "Mother of all deals" free trade agreement.

India and the European Union have set a year-end deadline to sign their landmark free trade agreement, described as the "mother of all trade deals", while also agreeing to deepen cooperation in defence, security and connectivity initiatives such as the India-Middle East-Europe Corridor (IMEC). India and the European Union have set a year-end target to sign their landmark free trade agreement, with both sides accelerating efforts to finalise one of the world's largest trade pacts amid growing geopolitical and economic uncertainties.

6. India's pharma industry sees hope after US, Iran agree to end war:

The Indian pharmaceutical industry is assessing its supply chain stabilisation options following a breakthrough framework agreement between the US and Iran. The preliminary deal outlines an immediate and permanent end to military operations across all fronts, including Lebanon, signalling a potential conclusion to the 107 day war in West Asia.

7. Centre to raise ₹13,000 cr via OFS in three state-run banks

The Government plans to raise around Rs. 13,000 crore through an Offer for Sale in Punjab & Sindh Bank, UCO Bank and Indian Overseas Bank to meet the minimum public shareholding norms prescribed by SEBI. The Government's shareholding in Punjab & Sindh Bank, UCO Bank and Indian Overseas Bank stands at 93.85%, 92.44% and 90.95% respectively.

8. Construction equipment localization scheme may cover port, container components

The Central Government is considering expanding the ambit of a construction equipment localisation scheme announced in the FY27 Union Budget to include components used to build port infrastructure and containers. The scheme, originally designed to incentive local manufacturing capacity of specialised construction equipment spare parts, was allocated Rs. 200 crore to the Ministry of Heavy Industries.

9. India overhauls food safety licencing, scraps permit renewal norm

FSSAI has introduced perpetual food business licenses, ending five year renewals for over 6.7 mn operators. The reform also exempts many street vendors from separate registration, raises turnover thresholds for licenses, and aims to boost ease of doing business in India's \$600 billion food sector.

10. India-UK FTA opens door for 88,000 Made-in-India green vehicles

The India-UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), which comes into force, is set to create a significant export opportunity for Indian automakers by opening duty-free access for up to 88,000 electric, hybrid and hydrogen-powered passenger vehicles in the UK market. According to the agreement, India will gain preferential access to the UK's green vehicle segment from the sixth year of implementation. The quota for made-in-India electric, hybrid and hydrogen-powered passenger vehicles will start at 17,600 units and gradually rise to 88,000 units annually by the 15th year, benefiting manufacturers such as Tata Motors, Mahindra & Mahindra and Maruti Suzuki.

11. India may introduce energy-efficiency rating system for electric two-wheelers

India plans to introduce standardise energy efficiency labelling for electric two wheelers to help lower charging costs and enable consumers to make informed choices. The labelling is expected to operate on the lines of the one-to-five star rating system for electrical appliances by the state run Bureau of Energy Efficiency under the Union Power Ministry. Discussions on the plan are in the initial stages and not in the public domain. A higher rating means greater energy efficiency, resulting in lower electricity bills and a smaller carbon footprint.

12. India Inc cuts entry-level hiring, bets big on high-skilled professionals: Report

India's employment market is witnessing a structural shift, with demand increasingly moving towards experienced and specialised professionals even as overall hiring momentum slows. The latest India Hiring Pulse for May 2026 by Choice Institutional Equities shows that while companies are cutting back on mass hiring, they continue to compete aggressively for premium talent with expertise in artificial intelligence (AI), cloud computing and digital engineering.

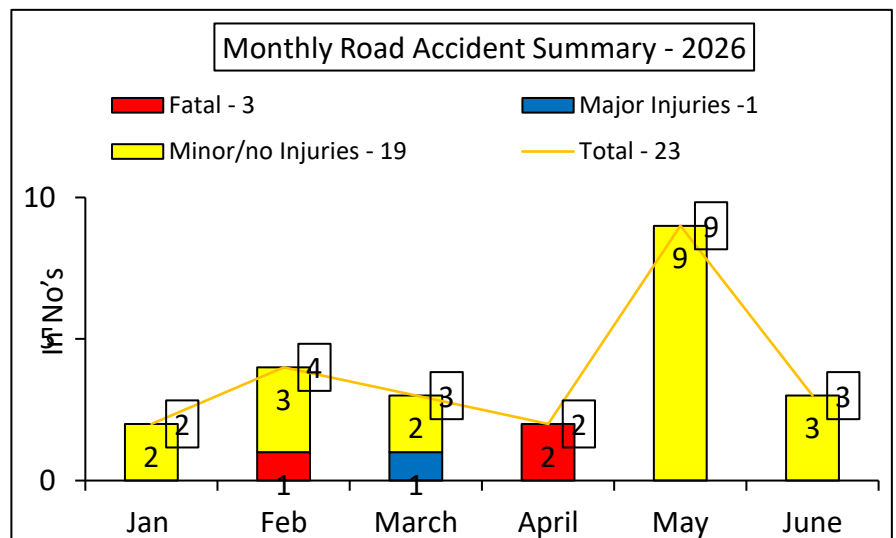

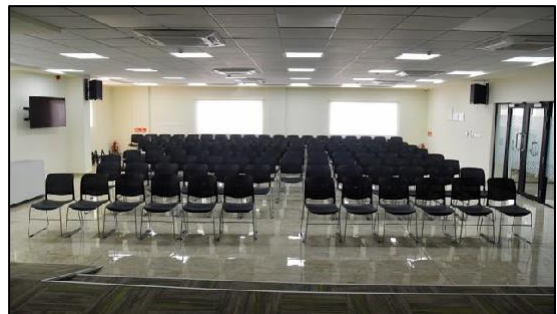
