1. Cabinet approves Semicon 2.0 : Government delivers on its commitment for a long term policy support to Semoconductors in India

The Union Cabinet on Wednesday approved the second iteration of India's ambitious Semiconductor Mission, with an outlay of Rs Rs 1.27 lakh crore. The fresh scheme will carry a key focus on subsidising the supply chain around chip manufacturing to attract companies producing commodities like gases, and chemicals used in the production process. The duration of the scheme is six years.

2. Cabinet approves Mobile Phone Manufacturing Scheme (MPMS)

The Cabinet of the Union granted consent to the Mobile Phone Manufacturing Scheme (MPMS), which comes with a budget of Rs 62,500 crore for five years for the purpose of improving India's electronics manufacturing sector. The MPMS is being approved at the same time as the Rs 1.27 lakh crore India Semiconductor Mission (ISM) 2.0 that has been designed to increase the shares of domestic value addition through the promotion of local production of components used in mobile phones, encouragement of design and research and development (R&D), reduction in dependency on imports, and increase in exports

3. India launches first hydrogen powered train built in the country to expand clean energy on railways

India rolled out its first Indigenously built, hydrogen-powered train, a move aimed at expanding the use of clean energy in its vast rail network.

The train made up of two hydrogen-powered driving cars and eight passenger coaches will operate in the northern state of Haryana. It can run at speeds of up to 75 kph (47 mph) and carry a maximum of about 2,600 passengers, railway officials said.

4. Karnataka plans to tap corporate social responsibility funds to upgrade 1,000 public schools

The department of school education and literacy has formulated guidelines for community and Corporate Social Responsibility (CCSR) through which it hopes to develop 1,000 Karnataka Public Schools (KPS) in the state. The department is inviting corporates, NGOs or communities for the establishment of new greenfield public schools or development of existing ones, including provision of physical infrastructure and maintenance for a minimum of three years or more.

India's Global Capability Centres (GCCs) are increasingly creating AI and digital talent internally by enabling professionals with adjacent technical skills to transition into the emerging technology roles, rather than relying solely on external hiring, according to a new report.

6. India Opens Bidding for 10 GWh Battery Manufacturing: What It Means for EVs and Domestic Cell Production

In a bold move, the Ministry of Heavy Industries is inviting bids for extensive Advanced Chemistry Cell manufacturing facilities, with enticing incentives for achieving a total capacity of ten gigawatt hours as part of the PLI ACC Scheme. This initiative is focused on grid-scale stationary storage applications, aiming to strengthen local manufacturing and decrease import dependency. Impressively, forty gigawatt hours have already been allocated to domestic producers.

7. Karnataka announces govt-driven AI university; pitches state as global hub for responsible AI

Karnataka Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar announced that the state will establish India's first government-driven AI University to become a global leader in responsible AI innovation. Alongside, the Government will also set up an AI Hub as an incubation centre for research and development in AI by start-ups, companies, and others.

8. Govt begins national floor wage exercise. What changes for workers ?

The government has started the process of fixing India's first statutory national floor wage under the Code on Wages, 2019, nearly six years after Parliament passed the law. The labour ministry has begun consultations with states and is preparing to constitute the Central Advisory Board. India has, until now, followed a National Floor Level Minimum Wage (NFLMW), a non-binding benchmark that states were advised to consider while fixing minimum wages. Once the relevant provisions of the Code on Wages are implemented, the floor wage will become part of the statutory wage framework.

9. India tightens hydrogen fuel testing rules as clean mobility push gathers pace

As India prepares to expand hydrogen based mobility, the Centre is tightening the technical framework for testing the quality of hydrogen used in fuel cell vehicles. The Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, has notified an updated Indian Standard laying down laboratory methods to measure impurities in hydrogen used in fuel cell vehicles as India builds its hydrogen ecosystem.

10. ‘India will offer 9% deployment incentive for startups to hasten chip designs’

India will offer a 9% deployment incentive to startups to accelerate chip design, a move that India Semiconductor Mission CEO Amitesh Sinha believes could lead to India creating its own chip patent within five fiscal years.

11. Gujarat tops NITI Aayog’s investment friendliness index; Maharashtra, Tamil Nadu follow

Gujarat, Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Goa have emerged as top-performing states in Niti Aayog’s new Investment Friendliness Index 2026, which ranks states based on quality of infrastructure, business climate, government policy and regulatory ease among other parameters seen as key to attracting investment. The highest weight of 25% is assigned to infrastructure, followed by business climate, resources, government policy, regulatory ease, financial health, institutional environment and environmental resilience. The index categorises Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Chandigarh, Chhattisgarh, Delhi, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Karnataka among other states as “frontrunners” and Bihar, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Puducherry, Punjab, West Bengal as “emerging performers”.

On business climate, Maharashtra led the rankings, followed by Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

12. Foreign insurers raise India bets as reforms reshape insurance sector

Foreign insurers are increasing their investments in India, re-evaluating joint ventures, and seeking greater control over their operations due to reforms in the Indian insurance sector.

Foreign insurers are raising their bets on India as regulatory reforms, stronger growth potential, and the prospect of full ownership make the market more attractive than it has been in years.

Reforms such as Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS), a proposed risk-based capital (RBC) regime, which requires insurers to hold capital in proportion to the risks they underwrite, stronger disclosure norms and improvements in digital public infrastructure are bringing the country's insurance sector closer to global standards, said experts.

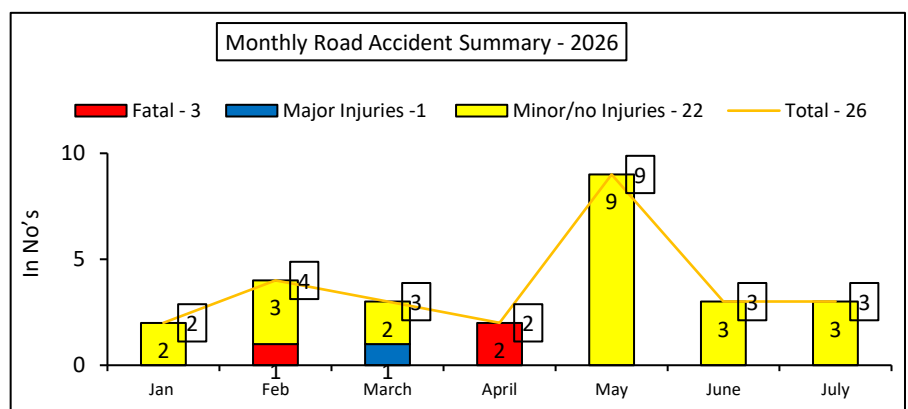
